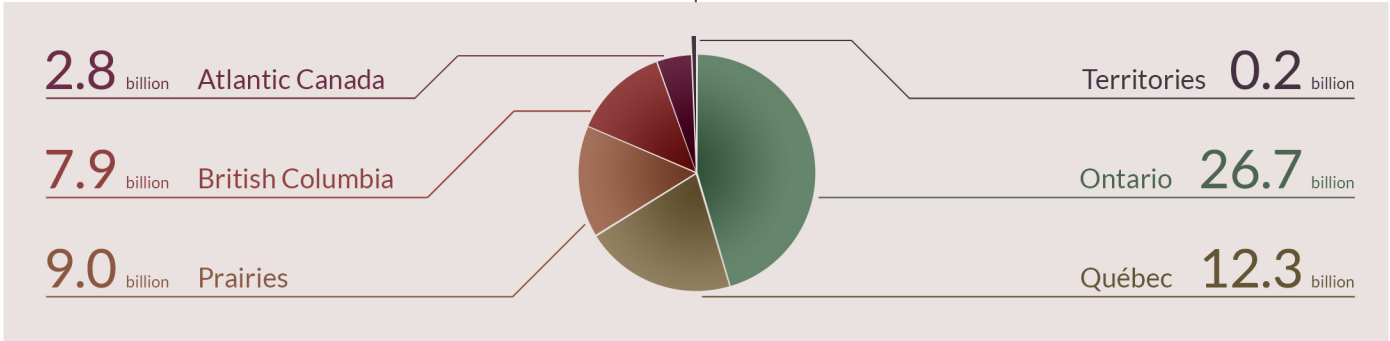
THE REGION AT A GLANCE

Over recent history, B.C.'s cultural sector expanded at the strongest pace in Canada. It is currently the **third largest** in the country after Ontario and Quebec, accounting for **nearly 14%** of Canada's cultural sector GDP.

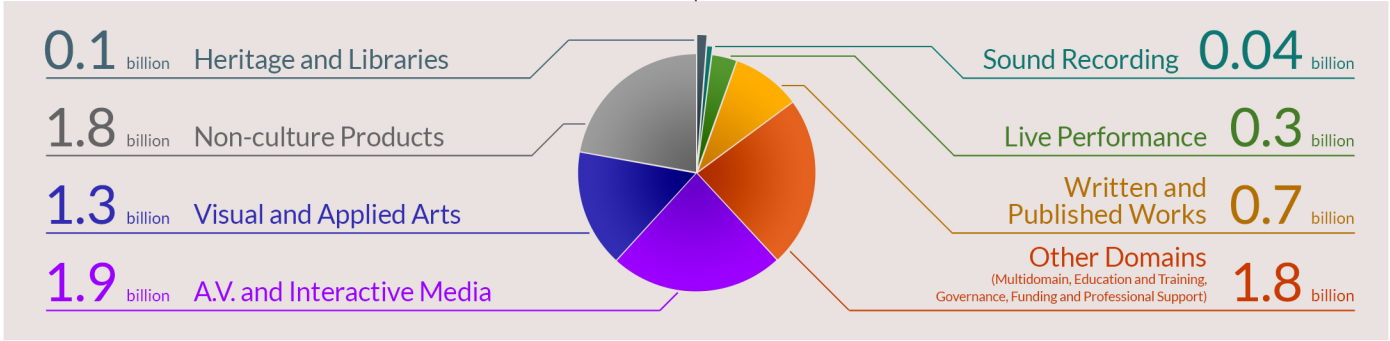
The outlook suggests B.C.'s cultural sector will **continue to expand at a solid pace** over the next decade, with gains in both employment and GDP.

While the strongest gains are projected to occur within the **audio-visual and interactive digital media domain**, solid growth is projected for most other cultural domains as well.

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN OF CULTURAL SECTOR GDP (\$ BILLION)



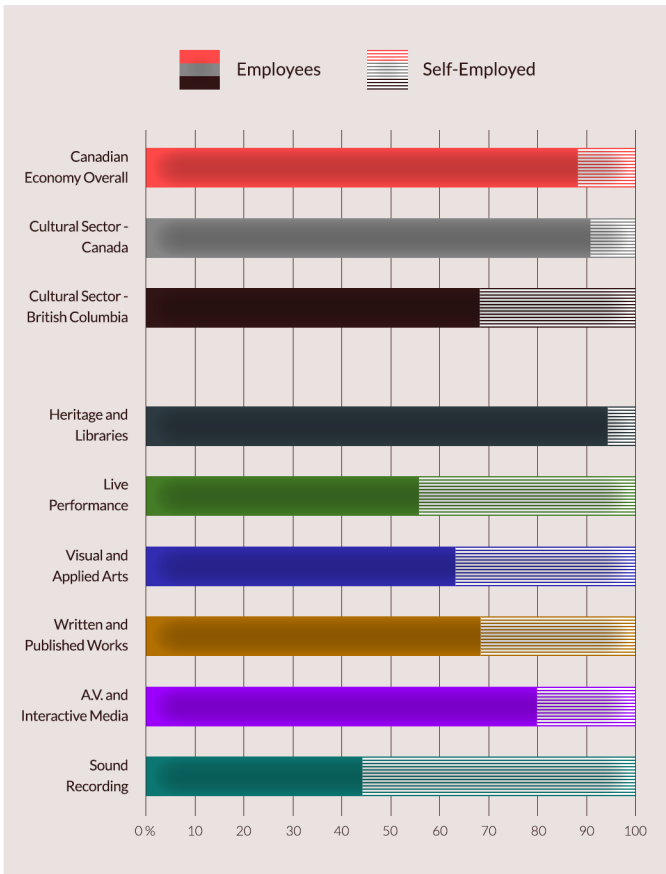
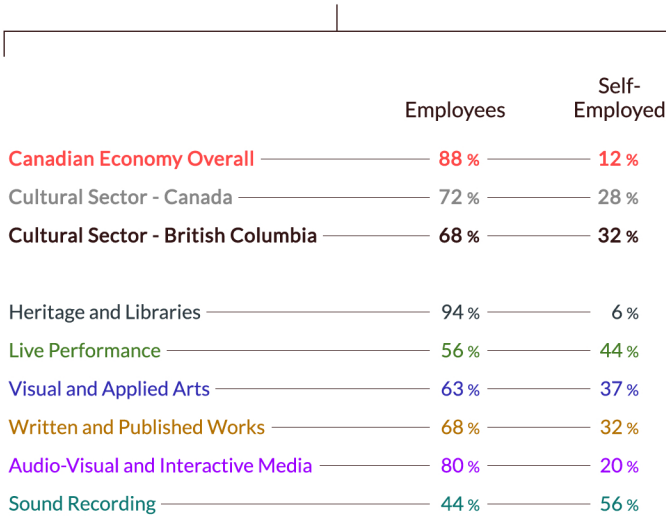
BREAKDOWN OF CULTURAL SECTOR GDP BY DOMAIN (\$ BILLION) BRITISH COLUMBIA

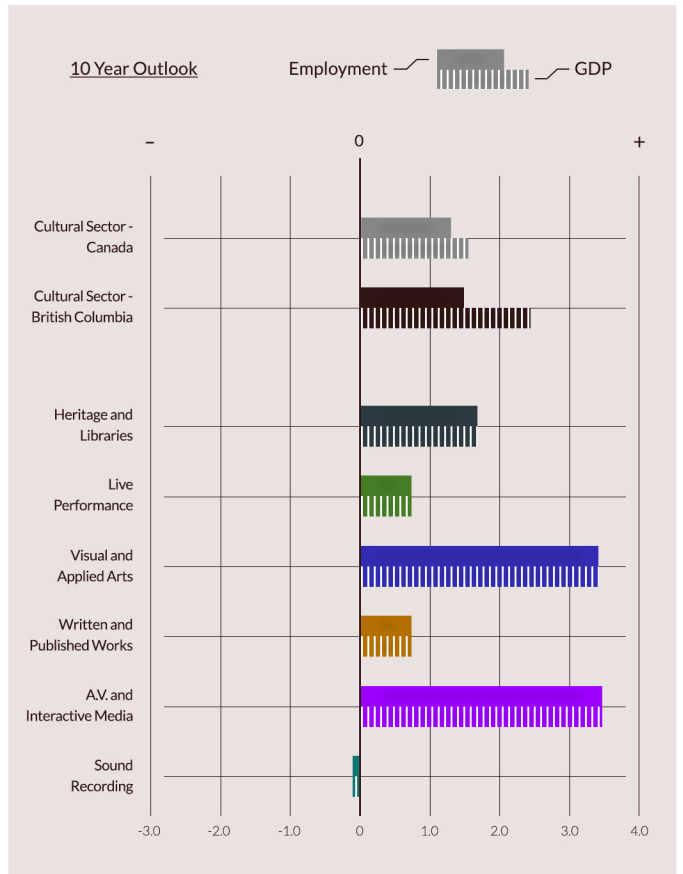
EMPLOYMENT STATUS

10-YEAR OUTLOOK BY DOMAIN (% AVG. ANNUAL INCREASE)



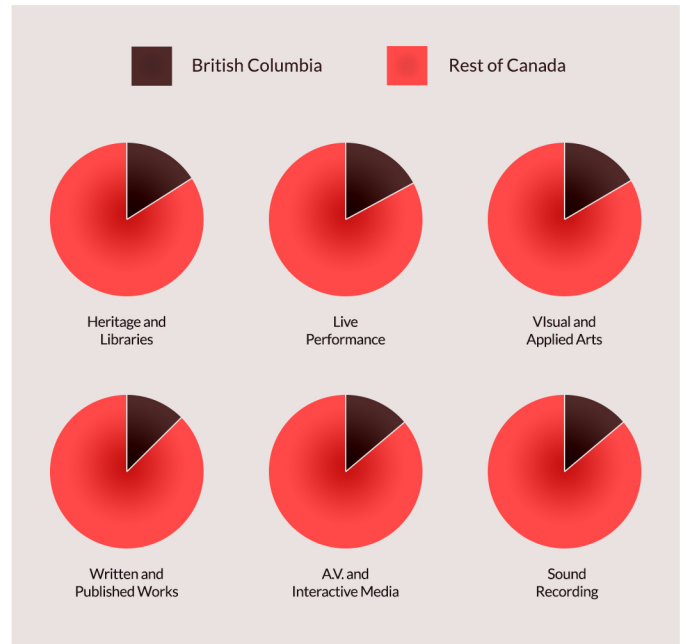
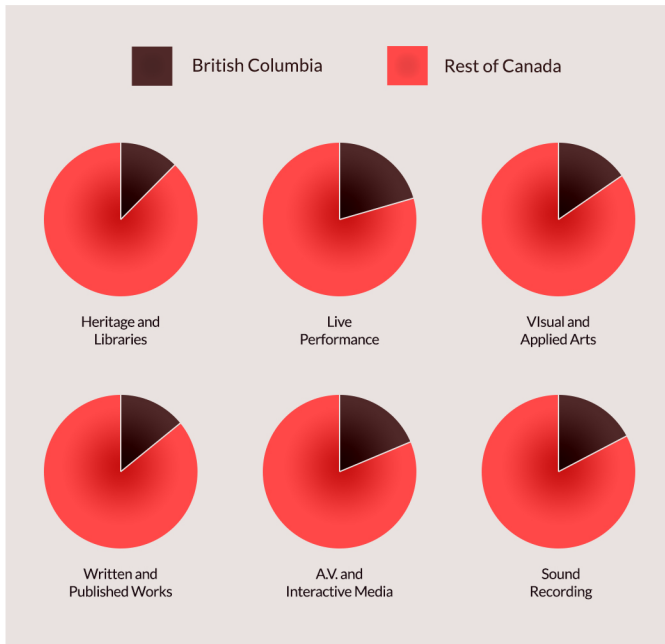
