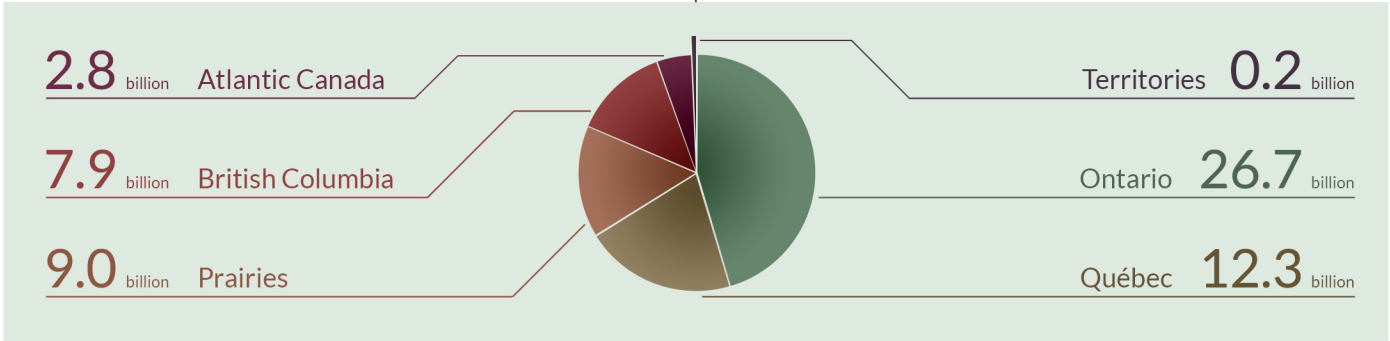
THE REGION AT A GLANCE

Ontario's cultural sector is the largest in the country - accounting for **45%** of the GDP attributed by the national cultural sector.

In fact, with all of the large employers (100+ workers) in Sound Recording located in the province, it is not surprising that over **60 %** of the GDP generated by the domain in Canada comes from Ontario.

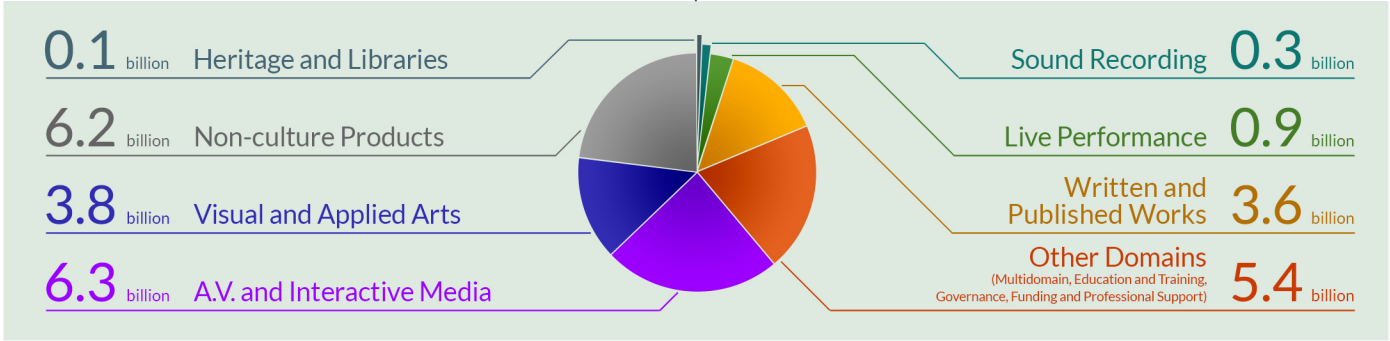
Aided by a growing economy and increases in population, the cultural sector in Ontario is poised to continue to expand at a solid pace. Growth in the sector is expected to be led by **Sound Recording, Audio-Visual and Interactive Media** as well as the Visual and Applied Arts domains.

BREAKDOWN OF CULTURAL SECTOR GDP BY DOMAIN (\$ BILLION)

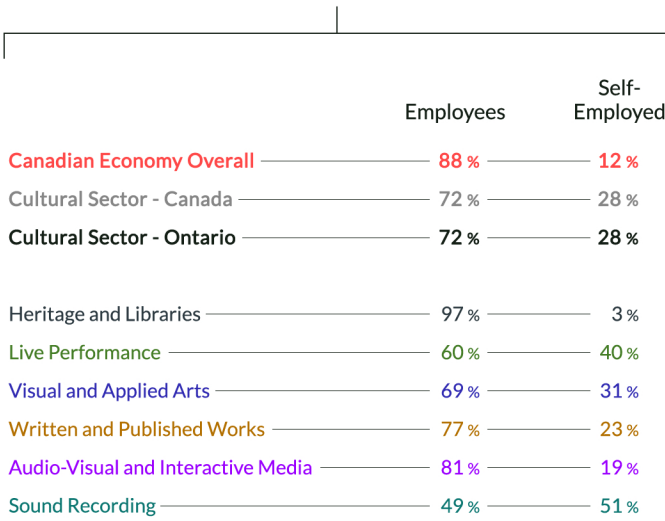

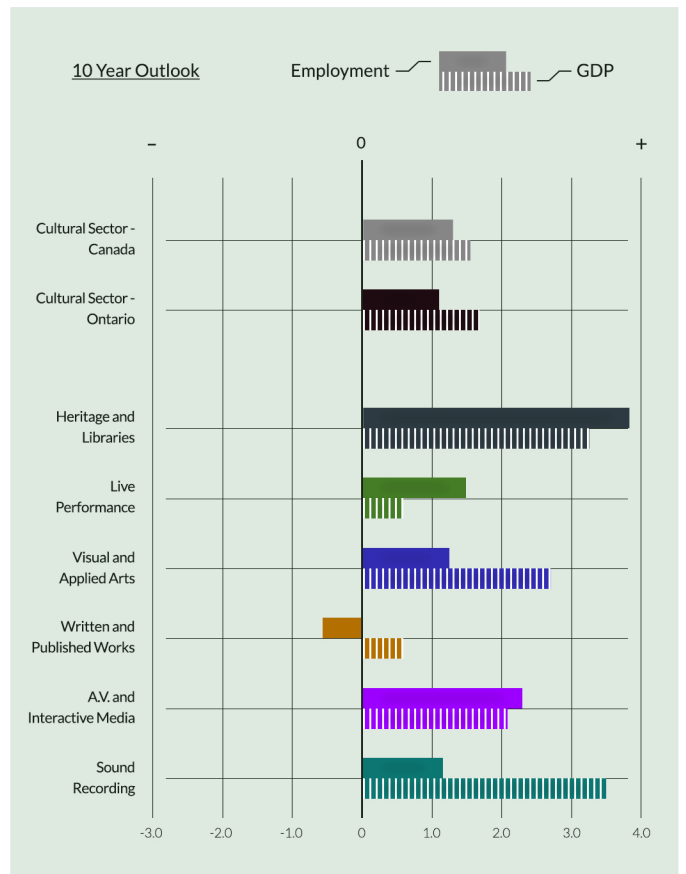
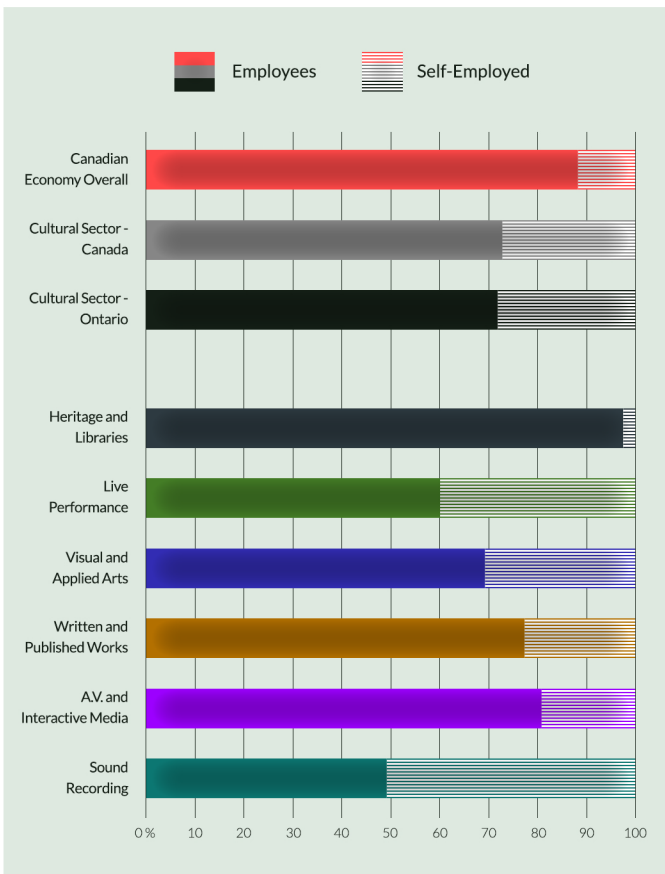
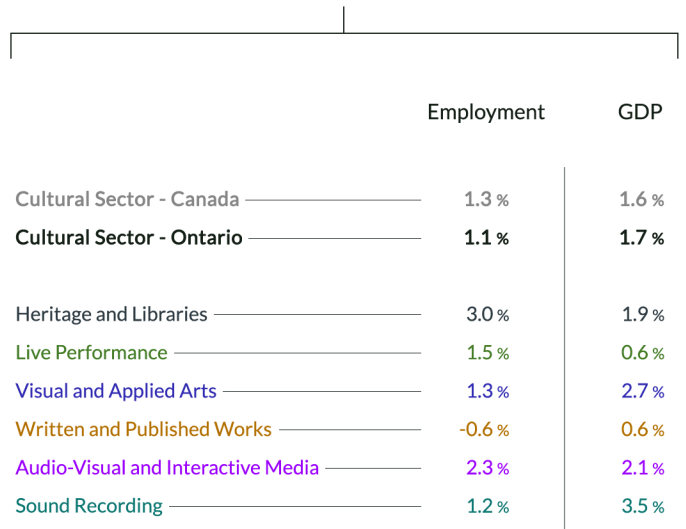
EMPLOYMENT STATUS

10-YEAR OUTLOOK BY DOMAIN (% AVG. ANNUAL INCREASE)



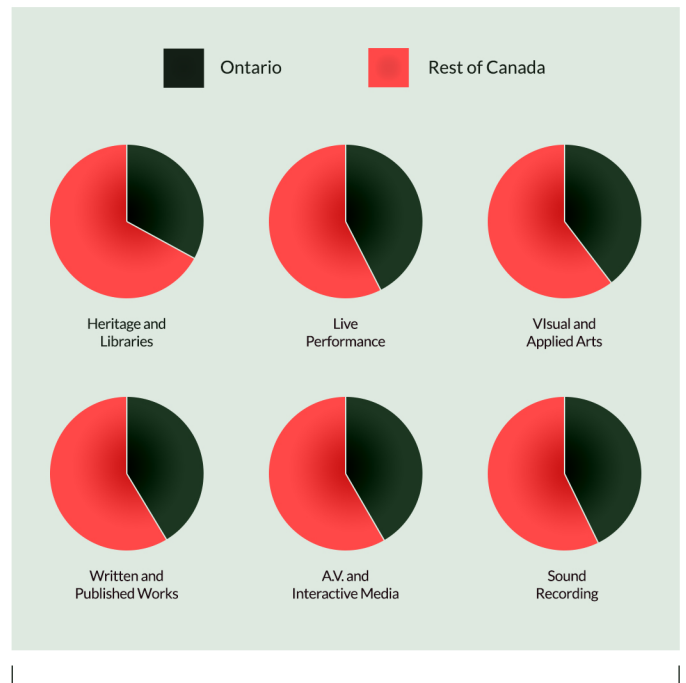
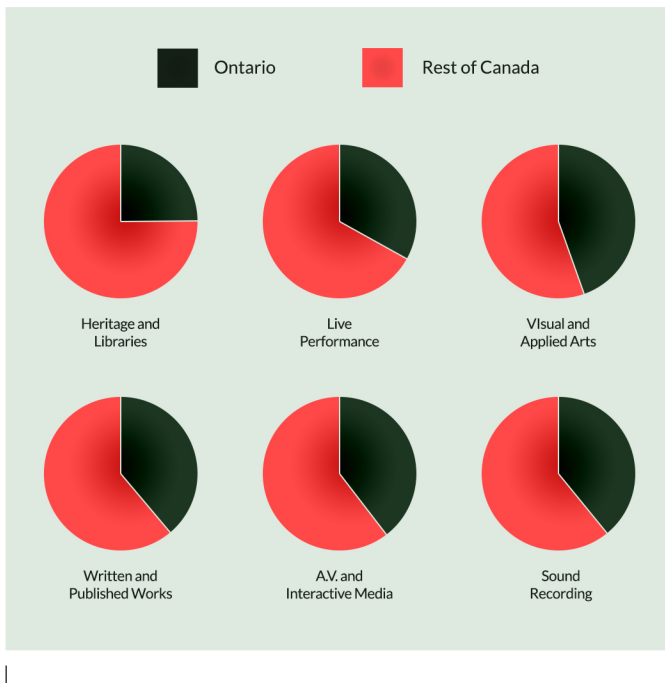
